Theme - Discuss the importance of love as presented in the play. Support your answer with details from the play.

Symbol - A symbol is a familiar object that is used to represent the unfamiliar. Find two symbols in the play and discuss them using specific details from the play. Title - Why is the play entitled Our Town and not A Town? Use content from the play to back your answer.
